Managers

- Ensuring risk assessments are undertaken considering work-related health hazards
- Providing appropriate information to staff about health risks
- Arranging appropriate training to enable employees to carry out their work in a safe manner, minimising the risk to themselves and colleagues.
- Ensuring early intervention in, and management of, work-related ill-health issues

- Making informed life choices about their health
- Informing their manager of any health condition that might affect or be affected by their work activities, the workplace, or other persons
- Co-operating with management in the implementation of appropriate measures to control health risks in the workplace
